


## Inauen-Schätti Hand-held Crimper

Ithough the folks at Inauen-Schätti's Swiss factory have bigger fish to fry selling their Avalanche Guard (formerly Dopplemyer's Blaster Box) and other avalanche safety systems, they are also marketing a new hand-held crimper. The tool neatly triple crimps varying lengths of detonators to safety fuse. An attached key turns a small set screw to vary the penetration depth that a detonator can be inserted in the device. As with other bench style crimpers, the unit is designed to contain and redirect the energy of an unlikely pre-detonation.
